

ARTICLE V. UPKEEP OF CEMETERY

In order to maintain the beauty and quiet dignity of the West Bend Cemetery, the following regulations shall govern the maintenance of the Cemetery:

1. No one shall do anything to disturb the quiet and good order of the Cemetery by noise or conduct of any kind, except such noise and conduct as is customary or necessary in cemeteries.
2. No person shall wantonly cut, break, destroy or in anyway injure any tree, shrub, flowers, grass or plant growing or placed on any plot or in any other part of the Cemetery.
3. No person shall throw, deposit, bring and leave any trash, filth or unclean matter or substance in the Cemetery.
4. No one shall in anyway disturb, mutilate, deface or injure any stone marking any grave, or any wall or inclosure around any grave in the Cemetery.
5. All grave markers must be substantially set upon proper foundation and so that they will not be disturbed by any cave-in, and subject to the supervision and control of the Caretaker.
6. The Cemetery shall not be used as a play ground or for play.
7. No owner shall inclose any grave, graves or lot, or plant any trees or shrubs anywhere in the Cemetery, except subject to the approval of the Caretaker.
8. No one shall use the Cemetery road nor its grounds as a public thoroughfare.
9. Every lot owner who personally cultivates or tends to his lot shall remove all trash and surplus material from the Cemetery to a place designated by the Caretaker.
10. Every monument builder and other persons doing work in the Cemetery, after erecting monuments, headstones, curbing, or doing other work, shall remove therefrom any and all trash and material brought thereto and not used, and shall leave the grounds and lots in as good condition as when the work was first undertaken.
11. Families of deceased persons, or persons appointed by them, shall be responsible for the removal of flowers and excessive dirt from the grave. The Caretaker is ready to assist in such matters.
12. Plot location, the placement of markers, and the general care of graves shall come under the supervision of the Caretaker.
13. No human body or human remains shall be removed or disinterred without the written approval of the Executive Committee of The West Bend Memorial Association.

RULES OF CEMETERY

1. All graves - 4' wide x 10' long
2. All stones that are set - will have to contact Memorial Committee.
3. All foot markers must be level with ground.
4. All headstones must be in line with existing markers.
